

Dear Mr. President,


We respectfully request that you grant the request made June 18, 2011, by Iowa Governor Terry Branstad, for a declaration of a major disaster for the State of Iowa as a result of severe flooding that began on May 25, in Fremont, Harrison, Mills, Monona, Pottawattamie and Woodbury counties. Governor Branstad has determined that this incident is of such severity and magnitude that effective response is beyond the capabilities of the State and affected local governments and that supplementary Federal assistance is needed.




